The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) hereby approves the Morro Bay National Estuary Program (MBNEP) Habitat Protection and Restoration Strategy (the Habitat Strategy). The Habitat Strategy is the remaining component of the MBNEP's Comprehensive Conservation and Management Plan (CCMP) and fulfills EPA's FY21-24 NEP Funding Guidance requirements. It also meets the intent of the 2021 Protect and Restore America's Estuaries (PRAE) Act by discussing recurring extreme weather events and climate change effects on the estuary and proposed adaptation strategies.
